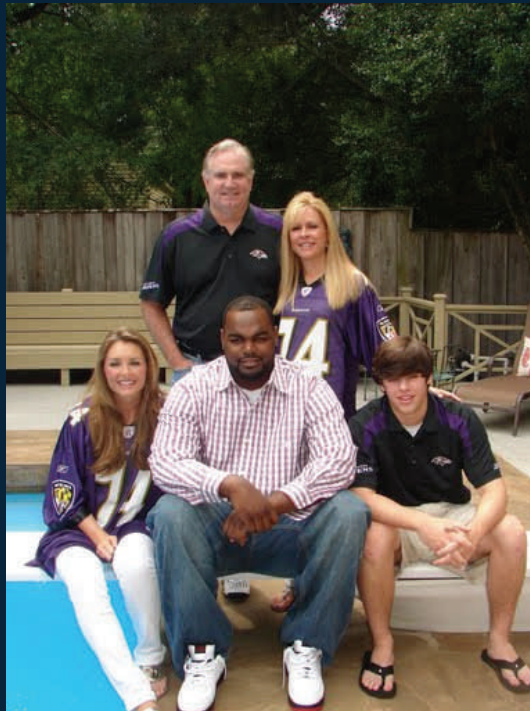

## Keynote Speaker at AOA-28: Sean Tuohy



This year's fabulous keynote speaker at AOA-28 will be Sean Tuohy. Tuohy is the adoptive father of Michael Oher, a homeless teenager turned NFL first-round pick and current offensive tackle for the Baltimore Ravens. Although widely known for his family's inspirational story, Tuohy also is a successful entrepreneur. He, along with partners Stanford Roberts and Michael Roe, own RGT Management Inc., which owns more than 80 restaurants under the Taco Bell, Long John Silvers, Kentucky Friend Chicken and Off the Grill brands. RGT's stores are located in five states.

Tuohy will present the keynote, "Behind the *Blind Side*: Overcoming Obstacles in the Face of Adversity," at AOA-28. This is one keynote speech you will NOT want to miss!

## About the Speaker: Sean Tuohy

Sean Tuohy knew what it meant to be the poor kid in a private school — he had been one himself. Raised in New Orleans, Tuohy's father coached basketball at the prestigious Isidore Newman School. After his father suffered a massive stroke, Sean continued to attend the private school, where he found himself on his own more than he ever anticipated.



With sports as his "meal ticket" through high school and college, Sean left New Orleans for the University of Mississippi on a basketball scholarship. When Sean walked off the court after his final game, he had shattered every major SEC assists-related record and become a legend in the SEC hall of fame for leading the Ole Miss Rebels to their first and only Championship. Drafted by the NBA's New Jersey Nets in 1982, he opted to continue his career overseas before returning to the US to be with his father in his final days. He became a successful entrepreneur, building a company that now owns and operates 70 fast food restaurants, including Taco Bell and Long John Silver's. Sean has been married to his college cheerleader sweetheart, the former Leigh Anne Roberts, for 27 years, and they are the proud parents of daughter Collins (23) and sons Michael Oher (23) and Sean, Jr. (16).
